Does Age Alter The Vitamin D Requirement?

Women of various ages may qualify for a research study. The UW Osteoporosis Clinical Research Program is currently looking for women volunteers who are:

- **Age 20-30, 55-65 or 75+**
- **Willing to limit your supplemental vitamin D intake to 400 IU per day**

Investigators at the University of Wisconsin are recruiting women to participate in a four-month research study to determine how age may affect our response to vitamin D fortified food. Qualified volunteers will receive a daily food supplement containing vitamin D and laboratory tests.

Participants will be reimbursed \$20 for each of 5 completed visits conducted either at the research office (2870 University Ave.) or laboratory (1300 University Ave. 2550 MSC).
