CALL FOR POSTERS

- We invite faculty, staff, students, postdocs, and others from UW-Madison to submit a poster that pertains to new research in the field of aging or life course studies for the Institute on Aging Annual Colloquium.
- The Colloquium is meant to provide information to the public about current research in aging, so posters should be written at a level that is comprehensible to the general public, who are the majority of the attendees.
- The IOA poster printer is available for printing accepted posters at no charge.

NEW INVESTIGATOR AWARD • \$500

- UW-Madison students and advanced trainees (including graduate and medical students; postgraduate trainees; and postdoctoral fellows, trainees, or research associates) who enter a poster can also apply for the \$500 award, which recognizes outstanding achievement among new investigators.
- Award applications will be accepted for research in any area pertaining to aging or life course studies (e.g., biomedical, psychosocial, or clinical/applied research).
- Work must be substantially the applicant's own research.
